Have a Clean, Green Halloween!

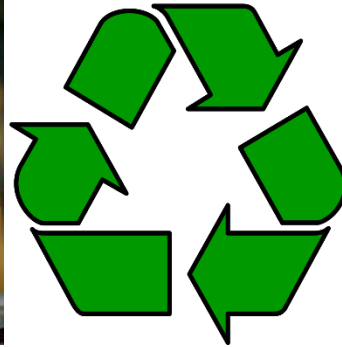
October is the run up to Halloween
