Did you know?

Segregating Waste

From January 1st, 2015, the UK waste regulations required businesses to fully segregate their waste into general and recyclables. This includes the below materials.

- Paper/Cardboard
- Plastic
- Metal
- Glass
- Food

Why?

- To reduce the amount of general waste going into landfill
- To increase recycling revenue
- To comply with government legislation
- To achieve zero to landfill

PLASTICS

Enough plastic bottles are thrown away each year to circle the earth four times.

Recycling one tonne of plastic:

- Saves 5,774 kWh energy
- Saves 16.3 barrels (685 gallons) of oil
- Saves 98 million Btu's of energy
- Saves 30 cubic yards of landfill space

Most plastic shopping bags are used only once and a plastic bag can take more than 100 years to decompose!



PAPER

Recycled paper produces 73% less air pollution than if it was made from raw materials.

Each tonne of recycled paper will save:

- 17 Trees
- 380 Gallons of oil
- 3 cubic meters of landfill space
- 4000 KW of energy
- 7000 Gallons of water

If every person in the UK recycled just 10% more paper it would save approximately 5 million trees each year.
